

SLSI Winter Olympiads

Socialist Labour Sports International (SLSI) (official name since Jan 08, 1928) was founded in 1913 by already existing national workers' sports organizations. In connection with and demarcation from „bourgeois“ Olympic Games of IOC, the International organized its own Workers' Olympiads (both Summer and Winter Olympiads) in 1925, 1931 and 1937.

After World War II, newly created successor Confédération Sportive International du Travail (CSIT) never obtained the importance of SLSI. But in the years between World Wars, SLSI was quite a sportive power with about 2 million members in 25 national organizations.

1925

1st Workers' Winter Sport Olympiad in Schreiberhau¹ (GER) Jan 31 - Feb 02

Ice hockey was not part of the program.

1931

2nd Workers' Winter Sport Olympiad in Mürzzuschlag (AUT) Feb 05 - 08

Ice hockey was included in program for the first time. Here, playing time was divided into 4 quarters.
