⁶ Originally Kilius - Bäumlér won silver ahead of Wilkes - Revell. Two years later the Germans were disqualified because the pair had signed a professional contract before the Olympics. So the Canadians were new ranked on 2nd and Joseph - Joseph on 3rd. However, in 1987, the Kilius - Bäumlér got the medals back after appealing that other figure skaters had signed similar contracts but weren't disqualified. In 2014, the IOC clarified that the 1964 pair competition had two silver and also a bronze medalist.

⁷ Some days after the competition IOC and ISU announced that it would award a second gold medal to Salé - Pelletier, and that the French judge implicated in collusion, was guilty of "misconduct" and was suspended effective immediately.
